The grant is for the teaching of agriculturally related subjects. Some sample lesson ideas are: genetic modifications, zoning for maximum farmland usage, and the effects of global warming on crop production. Some suggested uses for the grant money would be books, videos, lab materials, workshops, or field trips.
