Vitamins of concern in beef cattle nutrition include Vitamin A, Vitamin D and Vitamin E. They are usually reported in International Units (IU's). Fresh forage is a good source of Vitamins A, D and E. Vitamin content of well preserved hay is initially high, but declines over time.

Beef nutrition - Beef Cattle

Tract of cattle is important to understand cattle nutrient requirements and how best to meet these. The majority of feed available to grazing animals is high in fibre. That is, the feed contains large structural carbohydrates such as cellulose. Very few animals, and no mammals, have the enzyme systems necessary to digest fibre.

Corn commonly is used as a feed grain in beef cattle diets throughout the U.S. However, until recently in many parts of North Dakota and other northern-tier states, feeding corn was less common. With the availability and improvement of shorter-season corn varieties, corn plantings in North Dakota increased nearly 40 percent from 2008 to 2017.
