Liver cirrhosis is the severe scarring of the liver. It's commonly caused by viral infections, from fatty liver resulting from obesity, and from chronic alcohol abuse. A low-sodium, high-protein diet is recommended for liver cirrhosis to prevent or slow complications of the disease and to promote liver health.

Early non-specific symptoms include fatigue and itching. As scar tissue replaces healthy tissue and liver function worsens, a variety of liver-related symptoms may develop. Doctors usually require a strict no-salt diet for people who have cirrhosis with ascites, as a high-sodium diet can make the condition worse. 14 The daily recommended sodium intake for people with ascites is 88 millimoles per liter (mmol) per day. 15 The typical American diet contains 200 to 300 mmol of sodium per day.
