### Secretary's Standards--Archeological Documentation

All Information Security documentation within the scope of this standard must contain: Objective - the purpose of the document Scope - identifies to whom and/or to what assets the standards and process apply. Compliance - identifies the requirement to comply with the document and where to report non-compliance and to request exceptions.

### Documentation Standards for Information Security Documents ...

Guidelines, by nature, should open to interpretation and do not need to be followed to the letter. Are more general vs. specific rules. Provide flexibility for unforeseen circumstances. Should NOT be confused with formal policy statements. So, as you can see, there is a difference between policies, procedures, standards, and guidelines.

### Differentiating Between Policies, Standards, Procedures ...

Professional and legal standards: Documentation is a comprehensive record of care provided to a client. It demonstrates how a nurse has applied their knowledge, skills, and judgment according to the standards of practice. Documentation is also generally accepted as evidence in legal proceedings.

For documentation to support the delivery of safe, high-quality care, it should: 3. Be clear, legible, concise, contemporaneous, progressive and accurate. Include information about assessments, action taken, outcomes, reassessment processes (if necessary), risks, complications and changes.
