Isle Royale's 2019 moose population of 2,060 was a 300% increase from an estimated 515 in 2011, spurred by 20% annual growth rates. The wolf population, meanwhile, went the opposite direction, sliding to 16 in 2011, nine in 2012, and three in 2015 before leaving only Oedipus and his daughter/half-sister in 2016.

Additionally, Michigan's Isle Royale National Park in Lake Superior has around 15 wolves that are not included in the state survey. Crews with the state DNR and the U.S. Department of Agriculture Wildlife Services develop estimates by searching roads and trails for wolf tracks.
